



Tedd Wood Landmark Framed Cabinetry Features and Construction Details

Framed Cabinetry:

- Traditional full-frame construction with the choice of full overlay or inset cabinetry doors.
- Wall cabinets are 13" deep (compared to standard 12" D), base cabinets are 24" deep as standard.
- All wall cabinets *with overlay doors* have 1 ¼" reveal at the top.

Warranty:

- Limited Lifetime Warranty

Cabinet Sides:

- Unfinished side panels are 1/2" plywood set in 1/4" from the outer edge of the face frame leaving a 1/4" of scribe.
- Finished side panels are 1/2" plywood with 1/32" reveal, glued and pinned into the face frame.

Cabinet Tops and Bottoms:

- Top panel on wall and tall cabinets are 1/2" plywood, rabbeted, glued, and pinned into the front frame and side panels. No tops on base and vanity cabinets.
- Bottom panels are 1/2" plywood. They are rabbeted, glued, and pinned into the face frame and side panels.

Cabinet Backs:

- Back panels are 1/2" plywood, rabbeted into the side panels and set flush with the back edge of the side panels.

Shelf Construction:

- Standard base cabinets are half depth shelves. All others are full depth. Shelves are 3/4" plywood. They are adjustable every 32mm using 5mm pin system.

Drawer Construction:

- Drawer front, back and sides are 5/8" solid wood. Drawer bottom is 1/4" thick. The drawer sides are dovetailed, glued and pinned. The drawer bottom is rabbeted into all four sides and hot melt glued into place.

Drawer Guides:

- Drawer guides are under mount full extension with soft close.

Doors and Drawers:

- Doors/ drawers are produced in various hard wood species. Most door/drawer styles are solid wood but some will use other materials such as plywood or MDF to achieve the design style.
- Doors/drawers are finished to match the cabinet exterior.

Door Hinges:

- European soft-closing fully-concealed hinges.

Home Care Kit:

- Kit includes a touch-up stain pen and a wax patchall pencil.
